Our inclusive approach has allowed us to effectively support individuals facing diverse and complex challenges, ensuring they receive the care and assistance needed to improve their health and wellbeing.

- Homeless Individuals Supported: 150+
- Substance Abuse Recovery Participants: 200+
- Vulnerable Migrants Assisted: 300+
- Sex Workers Engaged: 120
- Traveller Families Reached: 75+
- Coastal Community Members Assisted: 400+
- Mental Health Support Sessions Delivered: 250
- Individuals with Learning Difficulties Supported: 180
- Multi-Morbidity Care Plans Facilitated: 220

Our inclusive approach has allowed us to make a meaningful impact on the lives of these diverse groups, fostering a healthier and more equitable community. Through continued collaboration and dedication, we aim to extend our reach and enhance our support in the coming years.

Achievements in Year One

Since its launch in Autumn 2022, the Community Health Catalyst Programme has achieved significant milestones:

- Direct Engagement Partnered with 20 VCS organisations in the area, facilitating direct support and collaboration.
- Comprehensive Signposting Connected individuals to over 40 voluntary and statutory providers for essential health and wellbeing services.

• Critical Services Provided - Delivered crucial services such as mental health support, health screenings, smoking cessation programs, cost of living advice, befriending services, and social activities, addressing immediate community needs.
