- Deliver community engagement and development across some of our **most marginalised communities** – empowering them to tackle issues that are important to them and develop their agency to make their own lives better. **If you can think of an under-served community in Medway and Swale, MVA are likely working with them** – including: homeless, vulnerable migrants, sex workers, addiction and recovery, LGBTQIA+, People of Global Majority, People living with mental and physical difficulties, GRT, victims of modern slavery and individuals with justice system involvement.
- Facilitate collaborative working and to provide platforms **for charities to radically transform** how they operate – future proofing their services for those that need them the most.
- Provide befriending support that can provide **a lifeline for some of the most lonely and isolated people** in Medway & Swale.
- Work alongside communities experiencing the greatest health inequalities – **providing practical information on cancer screening and earlier diagnosis** as well as empowering people to develop their own interventions through our Community Power and Self-Organisation model.
