- Build on our strong tradition of heritage-led-regeneration



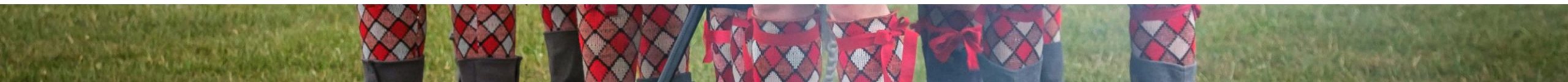
What is heritage?

Phase 1 – initiation phase

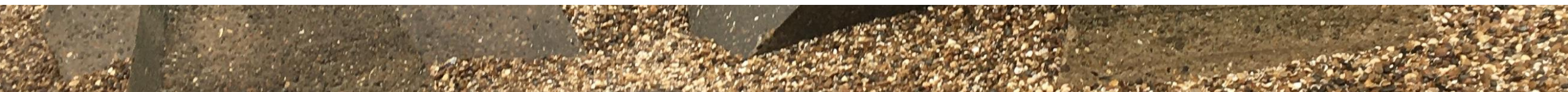
- Medway Heritage Audit

What we learned – our strengths

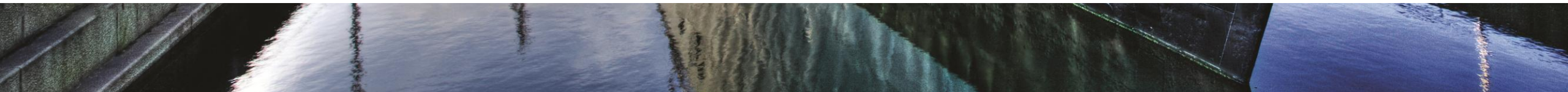
- Exceptional diversity of heritage assets

Phase 2 – building firm foundations

- A new heritage strategy and sector body
- Targeted sector and professional development
- Putting heritage at the heart of our visitor economy
- Strategic grant funding opportunities





Small-scale development grants

- £250.00 - £8,000.00
- Available to individuals, unconstituted groups and constituted organisations
- To pilot new approaches, tell new stories and learn new skills





Collaborative heritage project grants

- £15,000.00 - £30,000.00
- Available to partnerships of 2 or more organisations
- Pilot new partnership-driven approaches
- To support new ways of working that engage young people





Access and inclusion grant funding

- £1,000.00
- To support heritage sites and ongoing public engagement
- Free access audit, expert support, resources and site visits
- Support to develop an access improvement plan



The National Lottery Heritage Fund grants

- £10,000 - £250,000 - single stage process
- £250,000 - £10m – two stage process
- Support available to apply direct via Heritage Place team and Heritage Fund

- Supporting heritage organisations to explore new models
- Using time credits to diversify volunteers
- Growing the impact of heritage volunteering
- Addressing sector challenges
