- Enable corporates and public sector partners to collaborate and invest in trusted VCSEF organisations tackling various issues such as social inequality, injustice, the climate crisis and more.
- Offer VCSEF organisations a simple, fair, and transparent way to access funding and capacity-building support.
- Provide expertise in compliance, monitoring, and impact reporting, ensuring public and private funding is protected, well managed, and aligned with legislative requirements.
- Offer another option for single point of access for consultation and research opportunities - facilitating better social impact outcomes for local people through co-designed services/commissioning.



Currently powered by MVA in Medway & Swale and SEK in East Kent and, the SIG model has been designed for interoperability and agility to allow for future system/local government boundary changes.

What you can expect as a VCSEF affiliate:

- **Simple sign-up process** to access new grant opportunities

- **Eligibility checks and support** to help meet funder requirements

How It Works

1. **You sign up** once to join the Social Impact Gateway
2. **We notify you** when relevant funding opportunities go live
3. **You apply** through our simple application process
4. **A decision panel** reviews and awards grants
5. **We support you** with monitoring and reporting (if required by the funder)
6. **You receive funding** and deliver the work you're great at
7. **We help share your impact** — with the funder and the wider world
